Tours

Apple iPod audio tours - custom audio tour of the Museum of Art's 21-gallery permanent collection with 60 stops and is set with period music, character voices, and high-resolution digital images of all of the artworks. The cost is \$5 / \$4 for Museum Members.

Docent-led tours - Docent-led tours at the Ringling Museum of Art are free guided experiences for guests of the Museum of Art, *Cà d'Zan* and Circus Museum. Times are posted in the Visitors Pavilion on electronic monitors and on handouts. Tours are 30 minutes in length with 30 minutes between tours allowing for Q&A after the tour is over.
