



Information for Chaperones

Chaperones - share these guidelines with your group

One chaperone is required for every 10 students

- Chaperones must be 18 years or older
- Chaperones are responsible for their unit **at all times** and are expected to monitor students

Supervision expectations:

If the chaperone fails to correctly supervise the students, the group may be asked to leave the museum

- Chaperones must keep their unit together **at all times**
- Restrooms are available in the Children's Welcome Center at the Visitor's Pavilion, and on the north side of the Museum Courtyard Loggia, down one flight of stairs
- Care for and protect works of art by **not touching them**
- Do not lean on walls, pedestals, furniture, or art
- Walk at all times - no running, jumping, or shoving
- Speak quietly so that other groups are not distracted
- If a public tour is in the same gallery as you, please be very quiet
- No food or drink permitted in the galleries
- No backpacks, bags, or lunch bags

Museum Store

- Groups who wish to visit the Museum Store must be accompanied by their chaperone
- We suggest you visit the Museum Store at the end of your visit, in the Visitor's Pavilion
