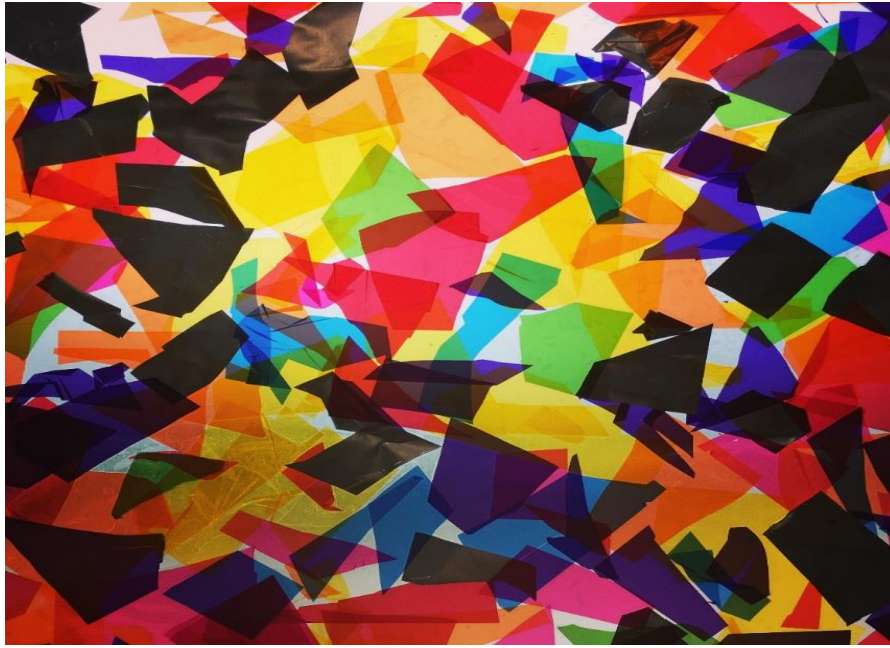


MAKE YOUR OWN COLLAGE



Today's activity let your little one explore the enchanting world of color and light! Light is an important aspect of artwork that we sometimes take for granted.

Check out what happens when you put your collage up against a sunlit window! What happens to the light during different times of the day?

The materials and instructions are provided to the right so you can re-create this activity at home!

Materials

Contact paper, colored cellophane cut into pieces, tape

Directions

- ◇ Cut your colorful sheets of cellophane into smaller pieces
- ◇ Place your pieces onto the sticky side of the contact paper
- ◇ Keep placing cellophane pieces until your paper is full of colorful shapes
- ◇ Tape your masterpiece to a window and watch how the light shines through the cellophane

◇ **Pro Tip:** Don't cut the cellophane pieces into exact shapes!



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
