#### **Historical Note**

John and Mable Ringing founded The John and Mable Ringling Museum of Art expressly for the people of Florida, opening to the public in 1930. On March 1, 1946, the museum complex was officially transferred to the State of Florida. At that time it was under the jurisdiction of the Florida Board of Control.



The Florida Board of Control was created in 1905 by the Buckman Act. This board was the statewide governing body for the State University System of Florida, which included all public universities in the state of Florida. In 1965, it was replaced by the Florida Board of Regents. The John and Mable Ringling Museum of Art and the Ringling Home, at Sarasota, were turned over to the Board of Control on March 5, 1946 by the Board of Commissioners of State Institutions. The Board of Control employed Mr. A. Everett Austin as Director of the Museum on May 1, 1946. Under the auspices of the Board of Control many needed improvements were completed at the Museum and the Ringling home.

The Florida Board of Control supervised the management of the Museum. Their primary responsibility were the state universities. Upon the recommendation of the Florida Board of Control who sought to "devote all of its time to the state's higher education institutions," in 1959, Florida legislation passed chapter 59-60, *Laws of Florida* that required a separate Board of Trustees to administer the Ringling Museums. The board was empowered to appoint a director and to oversee the workings of the Museum. The first meeting of the newly appointed Board of Trustees of the Ringling Museums took place in the Art Museum on June 18, 1959. The board would administer the museum under the State of Florida Board of Control, overseeing all aspects of the museum including budgetary and staff concerns, acquisitions and loans, admission policies, building and ground maintenance and compliance with state regulations. At the board's first meeting, an executive committee was formed by a motion approved by the board. It would consist of the board chair, vice-chair and a board member.

# **Description of Papers**

The Florida Board of Control collection holds four bound volumes and board meeting minutes and agendas. Each volume holds the membership of the Board, a letter of transmittal and reports from the chairman of the board, the board's executive secretary, architect to the Board of Control, the John and Mable Ringling Museum of Art; and from institutions under the administration of the Board of Control.
